We offer a variety of trips for you to enjoy; accessibility categories are defined below. Call us for wheelchair trip bookings.

NOT ACCESSIBLE (NA)

- No Walkers or Wheelchairs
- Active Participation Required
- Medium to long walks over uneven surfaces and stairs

PARTIALLY ACCESSIBLE (PA)

- Medium walks over uneven surfaces and stairs
- No Wheelchairs, Walker access may be limited

ACCESSIBLE (A)

- Walkers welcome
- Light activity with short walks
- Relatively level terrain
