Accessibility Levels



Not Accessible (NA)	No walkers or wheelchairs, active participation, and medium to long walks over uneven surfaces and stairs.
Partially Accessible (PA)	Medium walks over uneven surfaces and stairs, no wheelchairs, and limited walker access.
Accessible (A)	Walkers welcome, light activity with short walks and relatively level terrain.

Cancellation:

A trip may be cancelled 1 week before the start date if not enough people have registered. Unless otherwise indicated, all bus trips start and end at North Shore Neighbourhood House (NSNH) located at 225 East 2nd St. in North Vancouver.

Generally, NSNH does not provide refunds for bus trips or special events. If there is a waiting list and we can sell your spot, we may be able to refund the fee. A full refund will be given for any trip or event that NSNH cancelled. The Seniors Program Coordinator may authorize a refund for exceptional circumstances.
